**MUBS is hanging on a cliff edge
after playing to a goalless draw**

with rivals Uganda Martyrs University (UMU) in the first leg quarter-final clash of the University Football League yesterday at Nakawa.

MUBS will need a scoring draw to make it to the semifinals while UMU needs only a 1-0 victory to make it to the last four.

The highly-anticipated tie saw both sides miss scoring opportunities. But MUBS who failed to use their home advantage will need to go back to the drawing board to rectify their mistakes if they are to pick good results in Nkozi – one of the toughest grounds

to visit.

MUBS midfielder, Borris Onegi was named the Nile Special man of the match after putting up a good display.

This was the third time the two sides were meeting after the 2017 final at Namboole which Uganda Martyrs won 2-0 to lift the trophy for the first time.

Prior to that, the two sides had earlier met in the 2015 final which MUBS won 4-0 to lift the trophy for their second time.

Kyambogo University are the defending champions having won the trophy last season unbeaten.
