# 8,480 graduate in vocational skills

A total of 8,480 female graduands in vocational skills were passed out by President Yoweri Museveni yesterday at Kololo Independence Grounds.

Graduands from the 2018 and 2019 intakes of the Presidential Initiative on Skilling the Girl Child Project were drawn from centres in Kigowa, Mutundwe,

Luzira, Subway, Wandegaya, Nakulabye and Katanga, all Kampala suburbs.

Bakery had 1,720 graduands, hairdressing 2,59, tailoring 2,668, knitting 368, weaving 86, shoe-making 512, while spouses of soldiers attached to the Special Forces Command (SFC) were 528.
