Cyrus Kiviri added 15 points, five rebounds and five assists for Power, who committed 18 turnovers and converted only 30 of their

76 field goals attempts.

Michael Bwanga finished with a team-high 15 points for KIU, who were 21 of 74 from the field and guilty of 21 turnovers.

No other Titan player reached double figures and if you're looking for proof that a tough season awaits KIU, this is it.

Of course, Power were not much better but then the difference is they have the pieces, including the still

recuperating Joseph Ikong, to get much better.
